Katsunori Mikuniya was elected as the President of the IADI and the Chair of the Executive Council at the Annual General Meeting held in Québec City, Canada on 12 October 2017.

Mr. Mikuniya was appointed as the Governor of the Deposit Insurance Corporation of Japan (DICJ) in March 2015.

Before joining the DICJ, Mr. Mikuniya served as the Commissioner of the Financial Services Agency, Japan (JFSA) from July 2009 to August 2011 and a professor at the Policy Alternatives Research Institute (PARI), the University of Tokyo from April 2012 to February 2015.

Mr. Mikuniya started his career with the Ministry of Finance (MOF) in 1974 and moved to the JFSA at the time of its foundation in 2000. He has a working experience as a Secretary to the Minister of Finance, as a Budget Examiner of the MOF, as Director-General of the Planning and Co-ordination Bureau of the JFSA, and as Director-General of the Supervisory Bureau of the JFSA.

Mr. Mikuniya holds a Bachelor of Laws from the University of Tokyo.
