#### Expertise, Resources and Services

IPAB offers expertise in both *deposit insurance* and *failed bank resolutions*, including seasoned experience with bank closings and depositor pay-outs. Expertise also includes deposit insurance design, recovery and sale of assets, resolution methodologies, and the reforming of laws governing the bankruptcy and resolution of commercial banks. IPAB has also developed a series of detailed guidelines to prepare for and conduct bank resolutions.

IPAB offers *speakers and presentations* for training events held elsewhere. IPAB also offers *expert consultation* although usually via telephone conference and written correspondence, with some exceptions.

#### Objectives, Priorities and Financing

IPAB focuses on counterparts in Latin America and fellow deposit insurers, but not exclusive of other locations and parties.

IPAB covers travel expenses for its speakers and presentations abroad for certain events during the year which must be programmed and approved in advance. Expert consultations to be delivered on-site in other countries and jurisdictions may require recipient or third-party financing.

#### Alternatives Hosted by the Provider

IPAB hosts visiting delegations from deposit insurers on a periodic basis, typically groups of 2-4 individuals for up to 3 days at a time, and based on an agenda developed in advance. Discussions and presentations are conducted in either Spanish or English.
